

Dr. Jan van Hemert, Ph.D.

Jan van Hemert, Ph. D. was born in 1939 in the city of Rotterdam in the Netherlands. After finalising his studies and medical specialisation in Neurology and Neuro-Physiology, he became affiliated at the "Vrije University" as trainer of medical doctors and co-assistants. In addition, he was associated to the "Boerhave" method at the University of Leiden. Prof. Dr. Van Hemert was a successful medical director of several clinics based in Haarlem, the Netherlands.

His interests however, went beyond neurology and he conducted research in the fields of Spasm, sickness of Parkinson, Epilepsy, Psychopharmacology, Stammer, Hyperventilation and condition improvement. He also became an expert in the areas of Chiropractic therapy, Neutral therapy, Auricle Therapy en Geo-biology. His school developed a new variety of the application of the "Lecher Antenna" and is right now in the process of developing a telegnostic device to establish quicker diagnosis in a non-invasive way with the co-operation of the University of Palermo in Italy.

In 2006, he took the initiative to establish the first EUROPEAN UNIVERSITY for HOLISTIC MEDICINE in affiliation with the DUC University in the Netherlands, providing post graduate education in Holistic Medicine. He also established a research center and laboratory in his place of residence, being Egypt. His present research is mainly focussed on the applications of holistic medicine and he is currently writing a manual for theoretical medicine based on the quantum theory and the intentionality within medicine. Jan van Hemert is also part of a group international medical doctors who are active in the campus medicus of the American Hospital in Rome.
